


Lapa Cabernet Sauvignon 2015

Bold characteristics of dark fruits ease into cigar box aromas on the nose. Hints of tobacco and spicy cedar form wonderful complexity to the rich aroma

The substantially fruit driven palate is wonderfully supported by bold, ripe tannins. The balanced wooded characteristic and long lasting finish adds to the elegance and charm of this wine.

Vinified in open top fermenters. French oak 300L barrels for 18 months. 30% new oak.

Different soil types and climatic conditions allow for adding complexity to the wine. A diverse composition of soil and topography add complexity and an array of different characteristics to the wine.
