

Live with wine



Smoky mulberry notes with hints of pomegranate, followed by beautiful aromas of cherries and roasted almonds

The dark fruit rose petal and Turkish delight flavors on the pallet balance harmoniously with the gentle tannin structure to create a well-rounded and accessible finish

Vinified in a combination of open and closed top fermenters. Second and third fill French oak 300L barrels for 10 months.

Different soil types and climatic conditions allow for adding complexity to the wine. A diverse composition of soil and topography add complexity and an array of different characteristics to the wine.
