Varietals:

Pinotage and Cabernet Sauvignon

Wine Of Origin:

Western Cape

In The Glass:

Deep garnet in the glass, this semi-sweet red opens with an inviting lift of summer berries, ripe plums, and sun-warmed strawberries. On the palate, velvet-soft tannins carry layers of dark chocolate, vanilla, and exotic spice, closing on a long, smooth finish.

Winemaking:

Grapes are picked at optimal ripeness and transported to the cellar and de-stemmed into tank. The wine spent between 4 and 7 days on the skins depending on the tannin structure, with three to four pump-overs per day, and then pressed to undergo malolactic fermentation in tank. After completion, the wine was aged for 12 months with various types of oak, 12% new oak was used, before blending, a light filtration, and bottling.
