The Beyerskloof Pinotage boast with being South-Africa's most popular Pinotage, and it's no wonder. This wine has shown a fruity and enjoyable consistency year after year. Classic Pinotage. A wine made to enjoy, to drink at any occasion.

Wine Name: Beyerskloof Pinotage
Varietal(s): 100% Pinotage
Vintage: 2019
Soil: Hutton, Clovelly and Kroonstad
Trellising: Bush vines and 5 wire hedge

Vintage Notes: Despite good rainfall, the region was still affected by the preceding drought and realised a much smaller crop for the second year in a row. The start of the harvest was more normal and the early cultivars ripened well. The late cultivars ripened more uneven and later. The quality of the wines so far look really good.

Winemaking: Different systems of skin contact and fermentation in open fermenters, roto tanks and fermentomatics. 6 to 8 days on skins at 25°C. After malolactic fermentation the wine was treated with oak.

Bouquet: Primary fruit aromas lead to an abundance of red berries and plum.

Tasting notes: Strong red berry and plum favours with elegant tannins. Well balanced, medium-bodied wine with a fresh finish. Impressive for consistency, given the volume produced of this specific vintage. For a full favoured experience, we recommend drinking young.
