The nose shows beautiful nuances of blackcurrant, cocoa powder and black cherry which pulls through to the palate, lined by cedar wood and a floral undertone. The wine is juicy with supple tannins and a long lingering aftertaste of dried berries.

Enjoyed best with Lamb, Roast Turkey or Quail, hearty Boeuf Bourguignonne, or delicious Salisbury Steaks.
