Aromas of youthful black and red fruits allow for a fresh and lively nose, finished with hints of Christmas cake, cassis and cedar spice.



This wine has well integrated, full palate. Dark fruits of sweet spice elevate flavours of black Forrest and cherry cakes. This wine has a long complex finish with ripe grippy tannins.



Three cultivars vinified separately in open top fermenters. French oak 300L barrels for 18 months. 30% new oak.
