General	Our unique terroir and cool climate consistently provides concentrated grapes full of flavour with a distinct freshness enabling us to produce a Chardonnay which is crisp with an enticing complexity.
Description	Fresh and light toastiness on nose with butterscotch and nutmeg aromas. Medium bodied with an elegant structure, the wine has a flintiness with a balanced acidity that leads to a long finish.
Grape variety	100% Chardonnay
Wine record	In order to reflect the terroir, the Chardonnay was made naturally with minimal additives. Alcoholic fermentation and was followed by partial Malo-lactic fermentation in 500L neutral French oak barrels. After 9 months on the gross lees the wine was blended, settled and bottled after minimal filtration.

Maturation	Enjoy now or leave for a further 7 years to develop in the bottle.
