KC Cabernet Sauvignon/ Merlot

Vintage	2019
General	The KC range offers a light, fresh and easy-drinking style of wine. Grapes are sourced from mostly Klein Constantia & Anwilka vineyards, with the balance from premium vineyards in Stellenbosch.
Description	Ruby to deep garnet appearance. Flavours of redcurrant, plum and cassis fill the nose. A vibrant entry onto the palate gives way to ripe tannins and a sophisticated full body. Richly textured with subtle oak spice, the finish is long and punctuated.
Grape variety	Cabernet Sauvignon 47% & Merlot 46%
Wine record	The grapes were harvested by hand from our chosen vineyards sites. Extra care was taken during fermentation to ensure gentle extraction of tannin, leading to the creation of a lighter style of wine which displays both the varietal fruit and the terroir. Aged in a combination of French oak and stainless steel tanks for 14 months before blending and bottling.

Maturation	Delicious now, though will benefit from a further few years in the bottle.
