General	The KC Pinot Noir displays the true essence of the varietal whilst keeping it light, fresh and accessible at any time. In order to do this, we have sourced grapes from two of the best Pinot Noir terroirs in the Western Cape; Elgin and Hemel & Aarde. Each bringing their own unique character to the wine - Elgin showing light red fruit and Hemel & Aarde the more serious rich and complex character.
Description	Dark cherry red in appearance, the nose displays earthy aromas of red fruit with a subtle hint of spice. The fruit follows through onto a vibrant and full palate, coupled with velvety tannins and a fresh acidity. The wine concludes with a long and delicate finish.
Grape variety	Pinot Noir
Wine record	Grapes were fermented on the skins for a short period of time, then pressed off before the end of alcoholic fermentation. The wine was then aged on the fine lees for 9 months in a combination of 2nd and 3rd fill barrels and then blended, lightly filtered and bottled.

Maturation	Drink now or up to 5 years.
