General	Made in a Blanc de Noir style with minimal skin contact to allow for the perfect colour as well as light delicate flavours. Made from a single vineyard of Constantia Cabernet Franc.
Description	Bright and opaque salmon in appearance. A fresh & vibrant nose presents aromas of citrus blossom and vanilla. The palate is rich and crisp, displaying a balanced acidity and a creamy texture with hints of fresh peach. The wine concludes with a spicy and well rounded finish.
Grape variety	100% Cabernet Franc
Wine record	Careful attention was paid to the level of fruit ripeness at harvest. The grapes were whole-bunch pressed, yielding lightly coloured hues and fresh acidity. Once fermented, it was aged in a combination of neutral French oak and Stainless steel tanks for a period of 4 months before stabilisation and bottling preparation.
