The Pierre Jourdan range was named after the French Huguenot to whom the original Franschhoek farm was granted. The Belle Nectar is the latest addition to the Pierre Jourdan MCC range.

TASTING NOTES

The Belle Nectar is a bottle fermented sparkling wine created in a Demi-Sec style, created as a sweeter version of the popular Belle Rose MCC. As Belle Rose means 'Beautiful Rose,' Belle Nectar means 'Beautiful Nectar'.

This Méthode Cap Classique has a sweet palate and a salmon pink colour. The wine was matured on the lees in bottle for 12 months. Expect aromas of rose petals, strawberries and Turkish Delight.

FOOD PAIRING

This wine pairs well with desserts with strawberry and vanilla flavours. The perfect accompaniment to a high tea.
