HISTORY

The Pierre Jourdan range was named after the French Huguenot to whom the original Franschhoek farm was granted. This classic blend pays tribute to the base wine used for the Pierre Jourdan range of Méthode Cap Classique wines. As a still wine, the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay creates that same elegance with a beautiful peach hue.

Western Cape, South Africa

VARIETALS

Pinot Noir (60%) and Chardonnay (40%)

TASTING NOTES

Blended to be fresh and vibrant, expect tropical fruit, red berries and lime on the nose, which follows through perfectly on the palate. The Chardonnay adds a zesty lime character, with the Pinot Noir being fruit forward, which allows for a lingering finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Stands up well to spicy dishes, as well as lighter dishes. Pairs well with seafood and dishes with floral elements and vinaigrettes.
