This Moederkerk is pure straw in colour with a tinge of green on the rim. Notes of cool citrus, pebbles, white peach and baked apple are all knitted into wisps of fine French oak. Elegant and medium to full-bodied, it is a seamless expression of quintessential, modern-styled Stellenbosch Chardonnay. Rich but deftly fruited, a line of fresh acidity cuts a delicate balance with the deep concentration and texture. The finish is long and alluring, leaving an indelible mark on your palate. Irresistible now, it will age well for 5 years.

33% of the wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and the other 67% was fermented in old French oak barrels. The wine was then matured separately for 6 months before being blended just prior to bottling.
