HISTORY

This Single Vineyard wine is created from a block of Pinot Noir planted in 1992 and 1993 by proprietor Achim von Arnim on the slopes of the Middagkrans Mountain in Franschhoek. This site was specifically selected for its clay rich soils, which is very suitable for growing Pinot Noir. Only 1011 bottles available.

TASTING NOTES

This wine was matured for 12 months in French Oak barrels. Expect typical Pinot Noir characters of plums and red cherries, followed by subtle earthy notes. Can be matured for 5-8 years.

FOOD PAIRING

This Pinot Noir pairs well with meat dishes like duck breast, venison loin as well as carpaccio.
