
VESPER

GRENACHE, SHIRAZ, CINSAULT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON

2024 VINTAGE

Swartland, South Africa's bold, sun-kissed wine region crafting wines of character from old bushvines and rugged terroir.

IN THE VINEYARD

The story of this premium blend starts in the deep decomposed granite soils of the Paardeberg-Swartland, where time-hardened bush vines yield concentrated grapes full of personality and character. Harvesting is done by hand in small crates to ensure the fruit retains its freshness and integrity en route to the cellar.

WINEMAKING -

The grape bunches are meticulously sorted at the cellar to ensure that only the finest quality is vinified. Fermentation includes a 10% whole-bunch component and takes place at 23 degrees Celsius (73.4°F) for 12 days in concrete tanks. The wine then undergoes 12 months of barrel aging, with 10% in new oak. This process enhances primary fruit characteristics and preserves freshness while creating notes of spice and a lean, velvety texture.

TASTING NOTES & PAIRING -

This wine evokes the feeling of a Swartland twilight sundowner: aromas of wild berries, spice and smoke underpinned by an earthy, savory finish. Enjoy with anything on the grill, including vegetables.
