This layered, mineral-driven Chenin Blanc comes from bush vines with roots deep in the decomposed granite soils of the Swartland's arid Paardeberg ward. The strained vines produce concentrated fruit with complex personality. Grapes are hand-harvested in cool morning temperatures to preserve varietal character and freshness.
